There are three basic ways to replace a missing tooth, or teeth: a fixed dental bridge, dental implant, or denture (full or partial). The health of your teeth, gums and bone will determine the best option for your tooth replacement.

A dental bridge consists of two crowns on either side of the empty space, which are joined together by a replacement tooth (or teeth) that fills the gap. The bridge is made as one solid unit in the laboratory and cemented in place at the office. When compared to a removable partial denture, there are many advantages to a fixed bridge:

- It functions better for chewing your food.
- It looks like your natural teeth.

- It's stationary so you don't remove it at night (or misplace it).
- It doesn't move when you speak.
- It's more comfortable and feels natural.
- Keeps your other teeth in place.
- Won't alter your sense of taste.
- With proper care, it will last a long time.

Many factors will affect the longevity of your dental bridge. though crowns and bridges can't decay, the natural teeth supporting them can! Avoiding hard or sticky foods, getting inoffice cleanings at least every six months and maintaining your daily oral hygiene can extend the life of your bridgework. Give us a call today!

When she's not in the super clean work environment, she likes to be outdoors, and doesn't mind getting dirty by going four-wheeling and target shooting.
