

r. Long Huynh, owner of Park Family and Cosmetic Dentistry in Naples, is one of those people who make you feel like you matter. He is a good listener, has a gentle spirit and makes you feel safe, an important feeling to have if you are embarking on any kind of advanced dental treatments.

The doctor calls himself a product of the Vietnam War. His father, a soldier for the south, was imprisoned after the war, making times tough—to say the least—for his family. In 1991 they took advantage of a U.S. program to help families like Huynh's and moved to Atlanta. He says, "I was so grateful because they had this program for immigrants and helped with the language and employment."

Originally intending to go to medical school, he changed his focus to dentistry when he met his future wife and business partner Dr. Huynh-Le; her background is almost a mirror image of his. He says, "I actually look back at my career and it was best decision I could've made to be a dentist."

After relocating to Naples, Dr. Huynh decided to take on the arduous process of attaining an American Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry accreditation. It's a designation that sets the standard for excellence in cosmetic dentistry and one that no dentist in Southwest Florida had achieved. In fact,

less than 450 dentists in the nation have successfully passed the rigorous course work, and exams—both written and practical. And while it typically takes five years to complete, Dr. Huynh made it happen in 3 ½ years.

Not one to rest on his laurels, the dentist is going back for another accreditation, this time in dental implants. Dr. Huynh says, "I constantly try to improve myself. I want to set a good example for my associate dentists but the bigger purpose is to do what is best for the patients."

While he has put thousands of hours into learning and honing his craft, the compassionate dentist also puts hours into being a better leader. He explains, "I used to have 3 employees, now there are 35 families we are responsible for in my office." He continues, "My employees know I'm not a boss. We are leaders who add value to one another."

Dr. Huynh adds value in many ways, including personal growth. He has leadership meetings every week, gives his staff books to read and tools to advance their skills. He says, "It's a mission to make this the best place for an employee to work, to improve their lives, and a lot of patients feel it from the time they enter the door. It's quite fun, we are excited about it."
